ROCKLAND OPEN SPACE COMMITTEE MEETING, April 12, 2022 8:30 A.M.,

Mr. Cann called the meeting to order.

Mr. Cann stated there will be Town Clean-up event on April 30, 2022.

The Committee discussed the remaining work that needed to take place at the McCarty Farm in order for the Town to receive the approved LAND Grant funds from the state.

The remaining work discussed included the following:

Permits from the Conservation Commission to remove structures from the Farm property and expand the parking lot area to access the Farm.

Pam Titus will work with Lorraine Pratt to finalize a sign design per state requirements for the parking lot.

Dave Taylor discussed some details on how and when the farm structures will be removed and the general clean-up of the farm.

Mike Bromberg stated that Wildlands Trust will proceed working on the Baseline Documentation Report and Land Management Plan once they are notified that the farm structures have been removed and the parking lot area and signage is complete.

Doug Lapp discussed that he has a company working on placing all the necessary property boundary markers at all corners of the farm property per state requirements.

Doug Lapp is contacting the state about the reimbursement grant for expenses incurred do to the Land Grant.
