I attached the FPP mobile food establishment guidance documents. I don't see anything in 590/FC that prohibits porta-potties but it would be up to your Board of Health members what they want to allow.

From the attached MFE Standards document:

7. TOILET AND HANDWASHING FACILITIES

- a. Toilet and hand washing facilities must be available for MFE employees along their route of service. **(590.005;FC 5-204.11)**
- b. The toilet facilities must be conveniently located to the food preparation and ware washing areas. **(590.006;FC 6-402.11)**
